Number of participants per country:

The maximum number of participants a country can have is six. Four in recurve (2 men and 2 women), and two in compound (1 man and 1 woman).

Quotas for Paraguay as host country:

Due to its status as host country, Paraguay will automatically receive the following quotas:

- Recurve: 1 individual quota per gender, in total 2 quotas.
- Compound: 1 individual quota per gender, in total 2 quotas.

To compete in the men's and women's recurve team events of the Asuncion 2025 Games, Paraguay must win the team places in one of the two qualifying competitions, as any other NOC.





Athlete eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form. All athletes must be within the U21 category (athletes born between in 2005 or after).

Qualification system

Qualification for the II Junior Pan American Games Asuncion 2025 will be held in two competitions:

The participants by category in the Junior Pan American Games will be the following:

- Recurve Women: 22 (5 teams of 2 archers and 12 individual archers)
- Recurve Men: 22 (5 teams of 2 archers and 12 individual archers)
- Compound Women: 12 individual archers of 12 different countries.
- Compound Men: 12 individual archers of 12 different countries.
- Recurve Mixed Teams: As many teams as countries that qualified at least one man and one woman.
- Compound Mixed Team: As many teams as countries that qualified at least one man and one woman. The qualifying system will guarantee a minimum of 5 mixed teams.

The following places will be allocated in the Pan American Youth Championship in San Salvador:

For Recurve events

- Two (2) places per gender for each of the first three (3) countries in the team event.
- Paraguay may participate in the qualification team event and if it is placed among the first three (3), it will earn a spot for the Games' team event.
- The team event will be held separately from the team event of the Pan American Youth Championship. The teams' qualification event will be held with two archers from each country in each team. These archers must have been born in the year 2005 or afterwards.
- Archers born in 2004 may participate in the 2024 Pan American Championship but will not be able to earn spots for the 2025 Games.





- The best four (4) individual positions by gender (only one per country) for archers whose countries did not earn a team quota.
- If the 4 individual quotas are not completed in the qualification event, the unassigned quotas will be allocated in the second qualification event.
- This allocation of individual quotas will be held in a round of matches independent from the Pan American Championship, in which only athletes born in 2005 or after who come from countries that did not earn team quotas will be able to participate.

For Compound events

- One quota per gender for the three (3) top mixed teams (3 quotas per gender in total). The mixed team event of the first qualification event will be held separate from the mixed team event of the Youth Pan American Championship, to ensure the fulfillment of the age requirement for 2025.
- This mixed team qualification event will include only the archers who were born in 2005 or after.
- Archers born in 2004 will be able to participate in the 2024 Pan American mixed team event but will not be able to earn quotas for the 2025 Games.
- The best two (2) individual positions by gender (only one per country) for archers whose countries did not earn a mixed team quota (2 quotas in total).
- If the 2 individual quotas are not completed in the qualification event, the unassigned quotas will be allocated in the second qualification event.
- This allocation of individual quotas would be held in a round of matches independent from the Pan American Championship, in which only athletes born in 2005 or after who come from countries that did not earn mixed team quotas would be able to participate.

The following quotas will be allocated in the second qualification event:

For Recurve events

- Two quotas per gender for each of the first two (2) countries in the qualification event's team
- Paraguay may participate in the qualification event's team event and if it is placed in the first two spots, it will earn a team quota for the Games.
- This team qualification event will be held with two archers from each country in each team. These archers must have been born in 2005 or after.
- If a country that earns a team quota in the second qualification event had already won an individual quota in the first qualification event or as host country, the individual quota will be vacant and will be allocated in the second individual qualification event.
- The best six (6) individual positions by gender (only one per country) for archers whose countries did not earn a team quota in either of the two qualification events, or individual quotas in the first qualification event.





- If the total number of individual quotas for a gender are not completed in the two qualification events, the unassigned quotas will be allocated by World Archery Americas.
- The allocation of individual quotas in the second qualification event will be held in a round of matches in which only athletes born in 2005 or after who come from countries that have not earned team or individual quotas until then would be able to participate.

For Compound events

- One quota per gender for the two (2) first mixed teams (2 quotas per gender in total). If a country
 that earns a mixed team quota in the second qualification event had already earned an individual
 quota in the first qualification event, the individual quota would be vacant and will be allocated in
 the individual event of the second qualification event.
- The three (3) best individual positions by gender (only one per country) achieved by archers from countries that have not earned mixed team or individual quotas by then (3 quotas in total).
- If the total number of individual quotas for a gender are not completed in the two qualification events, the unassigned quotas will be allocated by World Archery Americas.
- The allocation of individual quotas in the second qualification event will be held in a round of individual matches in which only athletes who come from countries that have not earned mixed team or individual quotas until then would be able to participate.

Wild Cards

World Archery Americas will allocate one invitational spot in each of the four individual categories. The World Archery Americas Council will allocate the spots based on the selection criteria of having as many countries as possible in the Games, supporting the participation of more mixed teams in both recurve and compound archery, and including athletes who have achieved good results in the qualification events.

Confirmation of quotas

World Archery Americas will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that each NOC has qualified no later than March 25th, 2025.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and World Archery Americas the places they will use no later than March 28th, 2025.

Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, World Archery Americas will reallocate unused quotas to the next best positioned NOC that has not yet qualified, no later than March 31st, 2025.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than on April 2^{nd} , 2025.



Qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games

In Archery, all gold medalists of individual events will obtain direct qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games. A total of 2 places for each gender (4 in total) will be allocated in these competitions.

The places obtained are for the athletes, not for the country. If the athlete who earned the quota cannot participate in the Lima 2027 Pan American Games, the quota will be lost and may not be transferred to the country or to any other athlete placed in another position in the II Junior Pan American Games Asuncion 2025.

Athlete eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

Each NOC member of the BWF and the BPAC will have the right to participate with a minimum of one (1) athlete in the Badminton Competition of the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.

All of the participating athletes should be Under 23 (athletes born in 2003); athletes may be up to 22 years old by December 31, 2025.









Qualification system

The BPAC Executive Board has approved the following process for the allocation of quota places among the affiliated members of BPAC. The initial allocation would be as follows:

The countries' rankings are determined by adding the points of the highest ranked player / team from each country in men's singles, women's singles and mixed doubles. (A maximum total of the three rankings) using the BWF 2025 World Ranking of **March 4, 2025**. The higher the number of total points, the higher the country's ranking.

The allocation belongs to the country and not to the individual athlete. Each NOC may develop its own procedure for selecting its competitor (s) to participate in the Badminton Competition. To be entered, each competitor must also be eligible to participate in the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.

Depending on the number of countries that register players in the Junior Pan American Games, the BPAC has the right to adjust the participation levels upwards (when there are less than thirty-two (32) registrations per gender in the initial allocation) or the Qualification System of the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games downwards (where there are more than thirty-two (32) entries by gender in the initial allocation) to reach the quota of athletes; that is, thirty-two (32) men and thirty-two (32) women.









Confirmation of quotas

The BPAC will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places they have qualified no later than March 7, 2025.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to the BPAC the places they will use no later than **March** 13, 2025.

Reallocation of unused quota places

In case the quotas of thirty-two (32) men and thirty-two (32) women are not completed in the initial allocation, additional spots will be allocated as follows.

Starting with the 10th ranked country (two (2) or less entries), each ranked country, in the order of the ranking, will be allowed to enter one (1) additional man and/or woman until the quotas are completed or all countries have been offered and additional player, whichever comes first. If the quotas are still not completed, then the process will be repeated until the quotas are completed, with each country limited to two (2) entries for men and two (2) entries for women.

For this procedure the following dates will apply:

- a) March 14, 2025 (week #11) Panam Sports will inform to BPAC the number of spots that have to be reallocated.
- b) March 17, 2025 (week #12) BPAC will inform to Panam Sports and to the NFs the new allocated spots for the event.
- c) March 18, 2025 (week #12) Panam Sports will inform to the NOCs the new allocated spots for the event.
- d) March 26, 2025 (week #13) The NOCs will inform to Panam Sports if they accept the new spots for their country.
- e) March 27, 2025 (week #13) Panam Sports will inform to the BPAC the new list of spots for each NOC for the event.
- f) March 28, 2025 (week #13) Panam Sports will publish on its official website the final list.

Qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games

Panam Sports will grant all gold medalist in individual events, in both the Men's Singles and the Women's Singles, a direct quota for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games, which will not be part of the maximum quota indicated in the qualification process for these Games.









Personal title

- 1. The quota granted by Panam Sports is personal and non-transferable, as it belongs exclusively to the gold medal athlete.
- 2. The quota granted by Panam Sports may not be assigned to another athlete from the same country, nor to the silver medalist of the competition in case that the winner cannot participate.

Commitment to participate

- 1. To keep the direct classification granted by Panam Sports, the benefited athletes must meet the following requirements:
 - a. A minimum of 2 participations in international championships with World Ranking Points of the Pan American circuit within the **period of August 1, 2025, to July 31, 2026.**
 - b. A minimum of 2 participations in international championships with World Ranking Points of the Pan American calendar within the **period from August 1, 2025, to April 30, 2027.**

Loss of quota

- 1. By rejection of the NOC to the quota granted by Panam Sports.
- 2. Due to the inability to participate by the athlete, because of injury.
- 3. For not complying with the participation commitment criteria.

Athlete Eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete's eligibility conditions form.









All participating athletes must be in the Under 22 category, which according to the nomenclature established by Panam Sports for these Games, athletes must have been born between 2004 – 2009. In other words, they cannot be older than 21 years old and must not be younger than 16 years old in 2025.

Quota: According to the quota established by Panam Sports, there will be a maximum of 96 athletes in the canoe sprint competitions.

Qualification Rules

- 1. The first 5 boats in the K4 and C2 events of the 2024 Pan American Canoe Sprint Championships that are not from the host country of the Junior Pan American Games will qualify to compete in the K4 and C2 events at the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.
- 2. The first 3 boats in the K1, C1 and K2 events of the 2024 Pan American Canoe Sprint Championships that are not from the host country of the Junior Pan American Games, will qualify to compete in the K1, C1 and K2 events at the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.









- 3. Qualification will be exclusively in the official events of the Olympic schedule.
- 4. Countries that qualify for Olympic distances will be automatically registered in the non-Olympic distances, in which they must commit to participate.
- 5. All countries that have qualified at least one place for men and one place for women shall have the right to enter the mixed events in kayak and canoe.
- 6. The host country must participate in the 2024 Pan American Canoe Sprint Championships in all events it wishes to qualify for the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games, in order to validate its quotas. The awarding of quota places will be automatic with participation, regardless of the result. In case of not participating in any of the events and not reaching the maximum number of quota places provided for each NOC, the remaining quota places will be allocated according to the general criterion for reallocation of quotas.

Qualification principles

- An athlete may participate in as many races as he/she wishes, but may only qualify 1 place for his/her country. In case of running in several events, qualification will be for the largest boat that participates and qualifies. However, after the Pan American Championship, if the country does not accept the quota achieved for the largest boat, it may accept the smaller boats following the qualification rules of those boats.
- 2. If an athlete competes in more than one boat and in more than one event and finishes within the qualifying positions in all or some of the events, the doubling up rules shall apply.
- 3. The maximum qualification quota shall be 12 athletes.
- 4. All qualified and subsequently confirmed quotas must be compulsorily used and registered as starting athletes in the conformation of at least one boat in the Pan American Junior Games.

Repetition of quota rules by a single athlete (doubling up)

K4-K2-K1 rule: countries participating in 2 or 3 events with the same athletes.

- a) The 5 countries qualified for K4 that accept these quotas will not be considered in the qualification of K2 and K1, since they will have obtained the maximum quota of places.
- b) The 3 countries qualified for K2 that have not qualified for K4 will be the winners of the quota places. If a K2 in the qualification zone has a member qualified for K4, that is, that the country already has the maximum quota places, the full K2 quota goes to the next qualified boat.
- c) The first 3 countries in K1 that participate with an athlete who has not qualified for K2 and whose country has not qualified for K4, will be the winners of the quota.
- d) All of the rules above will apply once the countries accept their earned quotas.
- e) In case a country does not accept any of the earned quotas, said quotas will be reassigned to the next boat in the event for which it was not accepted.
- f) The finalist countries in the 2024 Pan American Championship qualifier for K1-K2 that qualified through the direct route of the event or by another route, will be automatically registered in the 2025 Junior Pan American Games. The country must commit to participate.





Rule C2-C1: countries participating in the two events with the same athletes.

- a) The 5 countries qualified for C2 will be automatically skipped in the C1 qualification because the maximum quota would have been achieved.
- b) The 3 countries qualified for C1 that have not qualified for C2 will be the winners of the quotas. If a country qualifies for C1 and is also qualified for C2, i.e., that country already has the maximum quota, the place will go to the next boat that is not qualified for C1.
- c) If a country qualifies for C2 and C1 with three different athletes, it will get only 2 places because of the maximum quota, as long as it accepts the quotas for the larger boat. In the case of declining the place in the larger boat, the country may accept the place in C1. In this case, the declined C2 place will be reassigned to the next unqualified boat.
- d) All of the rules above will be applied once the countries confirm their earned quotas.
- e) In the case that a country does not accept any of the earned quotas, these will be reallocated to the next boat in the race for which it was not accepted.
- f) The finalist countries in the Pan American Championship qualifier for C1 that are qualified through the direct route of the event or otherwise, will be automatically registered in the Junior Pan American Games. The country must commit to participate.

Confirmation of quota places

COPAC will confirm to Panam Sports and the NOCs the places that have qualified by November 22, 2024.

The NOCs shall confirm to Panam Sports and COPAC the places they will use by November 29, 2024.

Reallocation of quotas

General reallocation

Only NOCs that have participated in the 2024 Pan American Canoe Sprint Championships will be eligible to receive unused reallocated quotas to participate in the II Junior Pan American Games Asuncion 2025.

If one or more NOCs decide not to use one or some of the quotas obtained in the 2024 Pan American Canoe Sprint Championship, these places will be reallocated before December 6, 2024, according to the following criteria:

General rules for reallocation due to return of quotas after allocation.

• The unused quotas will be offered, in principle, within the modality where these were returned (men's kayak, women's kayak, men's canoe or women's canoe). They will be offered for the formation of the largest boats, first unqualified K4 in case of missing a partial, K2-C2 in case of missing a partial or the totality if more than one place is returned.









Priority will be given to maintain the quota of team boats specified in the qualification process. After this reallocation, if there are still quotas that cannot be reallocated to complete a team boat, said quotas will be allocated to individual boats.

- If there are fewer participants than the number of quotas allocated, an attempt will be made to reallocate the quotas for the event in which the minimum number of places is not reached.
- If an event fails to complete the minimum participation quota for the Junior Pan American Games, even after reallocation, those quotas will be awarded to the next event that does not complete the minimum quota of boats.
- If there are unused quotas, these will be offered to the NOCs that have not qualified any athlete and the order in which the quotas will be distributed will be according to the order of final positions in individual events.
- In the extraordinary situation that there are left over quotas that cannot be reallocated among the participants in the 2024 Pan American Championship, it will be at the discretion of the COPAC President, following the recommendation of the Technical Sprint Committee Chair, to reallocate the quotas directly to countries that have not participated in the qualifier.

The reallocation process must be completed no later than December 6, 2024.

NOCs that have received reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than December 13, 2024.

Qualification for the 2027 Pan American Games

In Canoe Sprint, all gold medalists in the individual Olympic events (K1 and C1) will obtain direct qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games. A total of 2 quotas for each gender (4 in total) will be allocated in these competitions.

The quotas obtained are for the athletes, not for the country. If the athlete who obtained the quota cannot participate in the 2027 Pan American Games, said quota will be forfeited and may not be transferred to the country or to any other athlete placed in another position in the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.

All Federations qualified by team are entitled to participate with a team of 3-4 gymnasts. No fifth alternate gymnast is allowed.

Athletes' eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form and should have a FIG License that is valid until the end of the event.

Men's Artistic Gymnastics athletes must be 15 and 18 years old up to December 31, 2025 (athletes born between 2007 - 2010).

Women's Artistic Gymnastics athletes must be 14 and 15 years old up to December 31, 2025 (athletes born between 2010 - 2011).





Note: 18 year-old MAG gymnasts that choose to participate in these Games may not participate in any Senior Category event during 2025.

Qualification system

Qualification for the Junior Pan American Games is based on the results of the 2024 Junior Pan American Artistic Gymnastics Championship that will be held in Santa Marta, Colombia from May 23 to 25, 2024.

In case of a tie in qualification, the tie break rules foreseen in Articles 7.1.1 and 7.1.2 of Section 2 of the FIG Technical Regulations shall be applied.

Quotas are for the NOCs, not for the gymnasts.

Starting with the teams qualified 11, 12, 13, 14 y 15 successively adding one Individual gymnast to each team.

If the Host NOC qualifies under any of the 3 first criteria, the Host NOC's individual quota will be reallocated to the next NOC in the Individual All Around standings that has not qualified yet under any other criteria.

The host NOC must compete in the qualifying event in the respective discipline (Junior Pan American Championship Santa Marta 2024) to receive its allocated places.

Entry quotas

The National Olympic Committee (NOC) is the organization in each Pan American country recognized by Panam Sports and the International Olympic Committee (IOC) as responsible for Olympic sports in that country. The Member National Authority (MNA) is the organization in each Pan American country recognized by World Sailing as the national governing body for the sport of sailing.

A country's National Olympic Committee may enter no more than one boat in each of the six Pan American Junior sailing events. Qualification procedures and rulings are the responsibility of the Panam Sailing Qualification Committee. The general timeline for confirmation of the allocation of country places to the NOC's and Entry by Name is described in this document.

The maximum number of places in each of the six Pan American Junior sailing events will be as follows:

Athletes' eligibility

- 1. The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.
- 2. An athlete may qualify an NOC for the Asuncion 2025 Pan American Junior Games only when eligible to represent that NOC under Panam Sports regulations.
- 3. Once a competitor has qualified a NOC in any event, he or she may not thereafter qualify another NOC, irrespective of any change in their nationality as defined by Panam Sports, or their ability to claim multiple citizenship.
- 4. All competitors must be at least 17 years old and not more than 22 years old in the year of the Pan American Junior Games (year of birth 2003 2008, inclusive).

NOC Qualification

- 1. The host country will automatically qualify one boat place in each of the six Pan American Junior sailing events.
- 2. The best-ranked NOCs in the men's and women's windsurfing events across the 2022, 2023 and 2024 World Sailing Youth World Championships will qualify one boat place per Pan American Junior Games event according to the quotas in the Qualification System table.
- 3. The best-ranked NOCs in the men's and women's kite events across the 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 World Sailing Youth World Championships will qualify one boat place per Pan American Junior Games event according to the quotas in the Qualification System table.
- 4. For purposes of NOC qualification in men's and women's events, men and women shall be ranked separately in regattas based on their final placement, where men and women race together. This approach will also apply to "age-groups".
- 5. Once a competitor has qualified a NOC in any event, he or she may not thereafter qualify the NOC in another event.
- 6. Equipment Class Rules requiring athletes to be members of Class Associations shall apply.





Qualification System

For the events to be considered valid, athletes from a minimum of three countries must compete in the corresponding event of the Qualification Regatta.

If a designated Qualifying Regatta is cancelled or fails to meet the requirement for a valid series, the places will be divided among valid regattas for the relevant event(s) in a proportion determined by the Qualification Committee. The Qualification Committee will attempt to maintain continental balance with respect to location in the selection of alternate Qualifying Regattas.

The Notice of Race of a Qualifying Regatta shall be reviewed and approved by Panam Sailing before the event.

The Notice of Race of a Qualifying Regatta shall specify that:

- a) For purposes of country qualification for the 2025 Junior Pan American Games, the Qualification System and Regatta Schedule, Sailing 2025 Junior Pan American Games, Asuncion, Paraguay (Qualification System), shall apply. See http://panamsailing.org
- b) All events designated as qualifiers for the Junior Pan American Games shall conform with the formats specified for those events in the Section of Maximum Quota Per Event of the Qualification System. For the Windsurfing events the equipment shall be the same as used in the Olympic Games (with the exception of the previous World Sailing Youth World Championships).
- c) A competitor may qualify a country for the 2025 Junior Pan American Games only when eligible to represent that country under IOC and Panam Sports and World Sailing rules and shall provide their valid World Sailing ID number to the organizer. The athlete shall be age eligible for the 2025 Junior Pan American Games all competitors shall be at least 17 years old and not more than 22 years old in the year of the 2025 Pan American Junior Games (year of birth 2003 2008, inclusive).
- d) Class Rules requiring competitors to be members of the relevant Class Associations shall apply.

The Principal Race Officer (PRO) for a Qualifying Regatta shall be certified as a World Sailing International Race Officer (IRO). Requests for replacement of the International Race Officer with a nationally certified Race Officer must be submitted for approval by Panam Sailing at least 30 days prior to the start of the regatta.

The International Measurer who serves as the Equipment Inspector Chief shall chair the Technical Committee for a qualifying Regatta and shall be certified as a World Sailing International Measurer (IM). Requests for replacement of the International Measurer with a nationally certified Measurer must be submitted for approval by Panam Sailing at least 30 days prior to the start of the regatta.





The Protest Committee for a Qualifying Regatta shall be constituted as an International Jury in accordance with Appendix N of the 2025-2028 Racing Rules of Sailing. The Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions shall specify that the right of appeal is denied, as per RRS 70.5.

EXPLANATORY NOTES BY EVENT

An NOC qualifies for the MIXED TEAM KYORUGI event if it has 3 or more athletes qualified in any of the events and fulfilling the maximum quota established per NOC.

NOCs that have more than 3 athletes must select the 3 athletes that meet the weight requirement per team, thus forming the mixed team. If any of the athletes had an injury before starting the individual competition, the NOC would have the possibility to use a substitute from the qualified athletes, as long as they meet the weight requirement.

I.- Qualification Criteria for Slalom, Tricks, Jump and Overall

- 1. Countries ranked from 1st to 5th place will be allowed 4 team members (20 skiers). Paraguay, as host country, will have 4 slots for its team (4). The 6th and 7th ranked countries will have 2 slots each for their team (4) the 8th ranked country will be allowed 1 slot (1). Three (3) wild cards will be granted to the countries that did not participate in the qualification event. These wild cards will be determined by the Executive Committee of the Pan American Confederation (3). The unused wild cards will be reassigned to the 6th, 7th and 8th place of the qualified countries, in that order. A total of 32 athletes may attend.
- 2. If Paraguay is ranked among the top 5 ranked countries, the next country ranked from 1st to 6th (24) will be granted the place with 4 team members. The 7th and 8th ranked countries will be allowed 2 slots each (4). The 9th ranked country will be allowed 1 place (1). (If the host country obtains a quota in the qualification event, this quota will be assigned to the next country according to the final positions). The 3 wild cards will be reallocated in the same way as described in point No. 1, for a total of 32 athletes.

II.- Requirements and composition of athlete quotas for teams

- 1. Each NOC may have a maximum of 4 athletes. Both genders must be represented; that is, an NOC may have a maximum of 3 athletes of the same gender.
- 2. When an NOC has a team of three or four skiers:
 - a. The team must have competitors representing both genders and each gender must have one competitor in each event.
 - b. No more than one competitor may compete in one event and at least one competitor must compete in three events. That is, there may only be one expert and at least 1 athlete must do all three modalities (jumping, tricks and slalom) in each team.
 - c. Only three skiers per gender and from the same country may participate in the preliminary rounds.

No athlete who has earned a qualification spot may obtain a quota in a different event or weight division.

The host country (Paraguay) will automatically qualify for all categories in which it has representation in the II Junior Pan American Games Asuncion 2025. However, Paraguay must have a representative in each weight division of the 2025 Pan American U23 Championship to confirm its quota in each category for the II Junior Pan American Games. There will be 2 wild cards per style, 6 in total, and the weight divisions in which they will be allocated will be established according to the following criteria.

The 2 wild cards per style will be given in weight divisions in which, taking into account the host country, there are less than 8 athletes participating in the qualifying event.

In case there are no categories with less than 8 athletes, the wild cards will be assigned considering the following:





- That in that weight division there is no athlete from Paraguay registered.
- The divisions with the lower level of competition will be taken into account, i.e. the divisions with the lowest number of registered athletes.

In case there are more than two categories with the same number of participants, the level of the division will be evaluated considering the following aspects:

- 1. Less amount of victories.
- 2. More defeats by touch.
- 3. The greater number of defeats by technical superiority.
- 4. Less amount of classification points.
- 5. Lower amount of technical points scored.
- 6. Most technical points received.
- 7. Once these points have been taken into account, the weight division in which the wild card will be assigned will be determined.

<u>Criteria for the assignment of Wild Cards:</u>

- 1. **Participation in Qualifying Events:** National Olympic Committees (NOCs) that participate in qualifying events but have failed to qualify any athletes will receive consideration for Wild Card places.
- 2. Athletes' Results: Within these NOCs, the Wild Card places will be awarded to the NOCs whose athletes have obtained the best results in the qualifying event, for example, if the wild card was awarded in the GR 130 kg. division in which we have 10 registered athletes and the venue qualified in 3rd place in the U23 Pan American Championship, the 8th place in the classification would be awarded and this place would belong to the country that fulfills the above mentioned criteria.
- 3. **Special cases:** In case no NOC meets the above criteria, the UWW and the UWWA will determine the reallocation of this wild card to the country they consider relevant, this to promote the principle of universality and support the development of the sport in the region.

Confirmation of quotas

UWWA will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs that have qualified no later than April 18, 2025.

No later than April 25, 2025, the NOCs must confirm to Panam Sports and UWWA the quotas they will use.









Reallocation of quotas

If necessary, no later than April 28, 2025, UWWA will reallocate unused quotas to the next best positioned NOC that has not qualified yet.

No later than May 2, 2025, the NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation.

Qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games

In Wrestling, all gold medalists of individual events will obtain direct qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games. A total of 12 quotas for men and 6 quotas for women (18 in total) will be allocated in these competitions.

These quotas will be allocated to the athletes, not the country. If the athlete who earned the place cannot participate in the Lima 2027 Games, said place will be lost and may not be transferred to the country or to any other athlete in the corresponding event of the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.

If a country qualifies another athlete of the same weight category and event for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games, there will be two athletes from the same country who are qualified for the same division.

In this case, both athletes must face each other in an additional combat on the same day of the competition, after the official weighing. The winner of this combat will be the athlete who will officially participate in the corresponding event in the Lima 2027 Pan American Games.
